Please read the notes below before completing the declaration:

- 1** You can cancel this declaration at any time by notifying the Church Office.
- 2** You must pay an amount of income tax and/or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax that Cornerstone reclaims on your donations in the tax year (currently 28p for each £1 you give).
- 3** If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and / or capital gains equal to the tax that Cornerstone reclaims, you can cancel your declaration (see note 1).
- 4** If you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief in your Self-Assessment return.
- 5** If you are unsure whether your donations qualify for Gift Aid tax relief, contact the Church Office, or ask your local tax office for leaflet IR113 Gift Aid.
- 6** If you are married and both pay tax, two separate declarations will need to be made if you wish us to collect tax from both of you.
- 7** IMPORTANT! Please notify the Church Office if you change your name or address.

Giving to Cornerstone

Cornerstone relies entirely on the giving of its members and regular attenders to finance its ministries and mission.

Standing order

One of the best ways to give is by standing order. This means that your giving to the Lord's work comes first, is regular and consistent. It also reduces administration both for the church and you. This leaflet contains a mandate to your bank for this purpose. Fill it in and return to the Church Office and we will do the rest.

Gift Aid giving

Gift Aid is a Government scheme whereby charities are able to reclaim basic-rate income tax payable on gifts received. This means 28p extra for every pound you give! In 2007 reclaimed tax was worth approximately £82,000 to us, without you having to give a penny more! It is an excellent scheme, and only involves you having to fill out a simple form, also included in this leaflet. Take a few seconds to complete it and your gift becomes so much more valuable.

If you are not a regular contributor to Cornerstone, please fill out the declaration anyway, as it applies to any and every gift to us that you make, however infrequently, even if you only make one gift ever!

Giving by cash

Even cash giving can be tax-efficient as long as the gift can be traced to you. This means it must be made in a clearly marked envelope. We provide these, so just ask a steward on Sunday or contact the Church Office and we can provide you with a supply.
